ANNOUNCEMENT: OSET Bikes UK will promote a Restricted Trial on 16th July 2016 for solo motorcycles, run under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions issued for the meeting.

ELIGIBILITY:

All riders must be riding an electric bike.

All riders must hold a current ACU Trials Registration/Membership Card or a SACU licence or ACU/SACU rider's licence. All riders **must** wear a helmet and clothing as per TSR12. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN, together with start permission and proof of personal accident insurance.

This event is limited to a maximum of 50 competitors. Entries will be taken on a first come, first served basis and will close on 1st July 2016 OR once the entry limit has been reached; whichever is the sooner.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE TAKEN ON THE DAY & NO TELEPHONE OR EMAIL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

When entering this event, anyone able to provide an observer is requested to so inform the Secretary of the meeting.

RESULTS: Will be announced on the day and published by OSET

AWARDS: Awards will be given to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each class after the trial.

COURSE: All on private land 4 laps of 8 sections. A lap will be approximately 0.75 miles in length.

The course closure method will be announced on day. Each section will have four routes; easy, mid, hard & elite.

METHOD OF MARKING & TIES: As per TSR 22a; stop permitted. Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23.

PROTESTS: Protests as per National Sporting Code of the ACU, section 10.04
